
ACTS 2

(1.) Discipleship Team – (Acts 2:42 - They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching . . .) This team will help oversee the coordinated discipleship efforts of adults in small groups, Sunday School, and special teaching events. This team will also assist in the strategic starting of new groups for discipleship.

(2.) Prayer Team - (Acts 2:42—They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching . . . and prayer.) This team uses focused activities, events, and Bible studies to encourage and disciple TCBC members and the community to prioritize personal and corporate prayer as a spiritual (Biblical) discipline.

(3.) Serving Hands Team – Part of caring for one another in the body of Christ involves helping out when there is a legitimate financial, special, or crisis-related need. This will involve being available to occasionally talk with individuals in need, pray with them, and when appropriate submit benevolent requests. Serving Hands will work to coordinate meeting needs of widows, single moms, elderly, and various needs as they arise.

INTRODUCTION

The Body of Christ, the Church, is made up of different people with different backgrounds, gifts, talents, and abilities. This kind of diversity is needed for the varied ministries carried out in the local church for the work Jesus Christ himself commissioned us to do. Paul explains it like this: 1 Corinthians 12:4-6, NLT—There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit is the source of them all. 5 There are different kinds of service, but we serve the same Lord. ⁶ God works in different ways, but it is the same God who does the work in all of us. With this in mind, we would like to help define the ministries and teams of TCBC and ask you to prayerfully consider where and how the Lord would have you serve.

WORSHIP & PRODUCTION

- (1.) Worship Team This team will minister to the church body on a regular basis using their musical gifts and talents to lead us in an experience of God-honoring praise and worship.
- (2.) Production Team This team serves behind the scenes to make it possible to better share Christ through sound, livestream, and screen presentation.
- (3.) Photography/Videography Team

 This team will assist in providing photos
 for website, brochures, and social media.
 Also, will be involved in the actual videoing
 and editing for use in worship services, social media, and special events.

HOSPITALITY

- (1.) Greeting Team Assist in giving guests on our campus a pleasant experience as they park, enter our facility, and get direction to our worship center, Kid's Ministry, restrooms, café, etc.
- (2.) Welcome Center Team Welcomes guests by offering a gift/information packet, answers further church-related questions, and collects guest information when appropriate. Also notifies church office of depleted supplies.

(3.) Kitchen/Church Fellowship Team - This team serves the church to plan for and sometimes to prepare meals or refreshments. This includes both church activities and special church-wide events.

FAMILY

- (1.) Women's Ministry Team This team is involved in the planning and carrying out of Bible studies, activities, and events with the purpose of building relationships, growing in Christ, and the understanding of His Word. The ultimate goal is discipleship among women.
- **(2.) Men's Ministry Team -** This team is responsible for providing opportunities for men at TCBC to be discipled. This includes offering Bible study, fellowship, recreation, and accountability.
- (3.) Kid's Team This team actively engages in the spiritual lives of the kids of our church. Service opportunities in nursery, preschool, KWX (Kids' Worship Experience), Bible study, and special events.
- (4.) TCSM (Student Ministry) Team This team serves in conjunction with student ministry leadership to support the plans and activities of middle and high school students such as small group Bible studies, fellowship gatherings, games, mission trips, camps, etc.

SECURITY/SAFETY

- **(1.) Medical Team** This team serves to respond to medical emergencies that may arise on the TCBC campus.
- (2.) Property Safety Team This team serves to deter, detect, and respond to threats and emergencies that may arise on the TCBC campus and help the church to respond immediately and wisely. Simultaneously, this team will assist in helping people know where to park (identifying parking for handicapped, single moms, senior adults, and guests) and where to enter the building. Will also assist on rainy days or with kids (as needed) and with late arrivals. Also informs church office of the need for new or better signage.

OUTREACH

- (1.) Missions Team This team serves to provide information and opportunities for service to TCBC in the areas of local, national, and international missions through prayer, giving, promoting, mission trips, and education.
- (2.) Community Outreach Team This is a new team that could potentially overlap some of the team above, however, this team focuses on Tega Cay and the immediate surrounding area and how we can reach out to local schools, first responders, families, certain special interest groups, etc.

STEWARDSHIP

- (1.) Finance/Budget Team In cooperation with the Financial Secretary, this team is responsible for the management and stewardship of the collected tithes, offerings, and annual budget.
- (2.) Counting Team This team carries the responsibility of collecting, counting, and recording weekly on-campus giving.
- (3.) Building/Grounds Team This team will focus more on the stewardship of our property and facilities. Attention will be given to planning, proposals, and physical labor needed to maintain and improve the church's physical resources, open buildings on Sunday mornings, have oversight of the custodial services, and to recommend policies.
- (4.) Personnel Team This team will help to ensure policies, procedures, and processes are in place to support church staff. Will also assist in annual staff reviews and evaluations.

(SPECIAL RESERVE TEAM)

This service team will not necessarily need to meet regularly but could potentially be available on an "as needed" basis for set-up for special events, help with bulletins (folding only), mailouts, special projects, making copies, etc.
